## Key words used/ Description of terms.

**Competency**: The overall expected capability of a learner at the end of a topic, term or year, after being exposed to a body of knowledge, skills and values.

**Descriptor:** Gives details on the extent to which the leaner has achieved the stipulated learning outcomes in a given topic.

**Generic skills:** These are higher order transferable soft skills that apply to all subjects and are commonly sought after in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century and the world of work.

**Identifier:** Is a label/grade that distinguishes learners according to their learning achievement of the set competencies

**Score:** Refers to the average of the scores attained for the different learning outcomes that make up competency.
